There were 85 people attended the camp which was an ice-breaking for new comers and better relationship building for the congregation. For most attendees, it was their first time attending church activities. After the camp, a few families brought their children to attend Sunday school and also expressed their willingness to take part in similar church activities in the future. **In June @ Guadeloupe**: Thank God that the "Joint French Speaking Youth Camp" between the 2 Islands - Martinique and Guadeloupe held on 6/26-29 in Guadeloupe was a successful one. There were altogether 41 attendants including 11 youths from Martinique. Pastor Joseph from Ottawa with a STM of 10 was the speaker. The theme was "Qui est Jesus?" (Who is Jesus?). This event certainly has benefited the young ones to grow deeper lives in Jesus. Moreover, we praise God for 7 young ones have accepted Christ as their Saviour.



**In July**: We thank God for we have finished conducting the "Cell Group Leadership" training. We plan to divide the island into 4 areas starting in September. Each area would start bimonthly cell group with Bible study.
