Prior to our arrival to Norway, we have been praying that we can be the mobilizers for the NextGen ministries beyond the four walls of the churches. However, this has been a very difficult task, since we have sent out messages to a large number of NextGen workers and organizations with no replies at all. Later, we learned that this is not the typical way for Norwegians to



network. Then, we started to attend as many external NextGen meetings/activities as our schedule permitted, on top of hosting "fika"(coffee/tea time) among NextGen workers. In this our 3rd year of ministry, we have begun to see results, praise the Lord! We are now more connected with NextGen workers from other churches and organizations in Oslo; and are cohosting events with them.



Sports is a big focus for families in Norway. We have connected with KRIK (Norwegian Christian Sports) and are looking into start a joint program for our fellowship in Bergen. KRIK would like to extend their program to ethnic churches; and we are trying to reach out to young families in the community. After much prayer and discussion with KRIK and co-workers in Bergen, we are planning a new joint venture program starting January 1, 2020! Please pray for a blessing from this partnership.
