## Dear prayer partner,

For the past few years, we saw how God is raising up a church planting movement in Mexico City among the local and mission churches. It is an answer to prayers!! In our last few newsletters, we have asked you to pray specifically for God's guidance, wisdom and discernment as we look towards our next term in Mexico.

After much communication and prayers with our Mexico team leaders, we have some more clarity on how you can pray for us. Our proposed project will be to work with the least reached within three least reached people (LRP) groups in Mexico City. These LRP groups will be Chinese Mexicans, local Mexicans and foreign Chinese working in Mexico City. There are only two Chinese mission churches in Mexico City with total congregation of less than 200 that serves Chinese ancestry and heritage. The church planting vision for this project is to plant a local church to serve the "white collar" segment. The least reached amongst the educated and career professionals and as such, our target will be possibly a trilingual church plant with Spanish as the primary, then English and Chinese.

We are very excited for this new venture to meet the spiritual need of these unique LRP groups!!Will you please pray with us for this new season of ministry? Although there are many unknown ahead of us, we trust the Lord will lead the way as we seek His guidance.

We are thankful that early May, we had a great time of much needed rest and celebrated our wedding anniversary in China and Taiwan. God also used this trip to help us understand more about Chinese culture and traditions. We preached/shared mid-May at two churches and look forward to attending the Eastern District conference in Ottawa end of May.

We would love to connect with you as we will travel to Saskatoon in June 9-12 and attend the CCACA Annual Conference and Joint Mission Conference in Hamilton from August 3-7. Do visit our booth and attend our workshops there.
